KEERTANA chased the pace along the inside through the turn, angled into the three path entering the lane when moving to engage the leader, moved to near even terms near the eighth pole, lost some ground to the rallying runner-up then made a determined run to be up in time. FLEET STREAK was along the inside through the turn when passing rivals, waited briefly outside the quarter pole when full of run, got through along the inside entering the lane when others fanned wide, opened a clear advantage inside the eighth pole then could not hold off the winner. COMPLICITY was unhurried while in the two path through the turn, angled into the five path when gaining momentum into the lane then was gaining to the end. SENIGA set the pace along the inside into the lane, was challenged outside the eighth pole and yielded. BANKER'S CHOICE was unhurried while in the three path into the turn, moved five wide into the lane then finished evenly while not a serious threat. EXCELENTE (IRE) stalked the pace three wide through the turn and weakened in the drive. SUPER PONI was near the rail through the turn and never factored. DONNA D chased the pace form the two or three path into the turn then tired. UNEVEN stalked the pace two wide through the turn then retreated down the lane. DOUBLE ESPRESSO was four wide through the first and second turn when never far back, appeared to be tiring when checked near the quarter pole when another came in and was finished.
