6 FURLONGS. (1.08+) 35TH RUNNING OF THE AZALEA. Grade III. Purse \$200,000 FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start - with \$200,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; once, 5 lbs.; \$35,000, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner and Trainer. Closed Saturday, June 27, 2009 with 16 nominations.

FIRST PASSAGE allowed to settle, rallied four wide around the turn, moved to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. KAYS AND JAYS showed speed along the inside, responded when headed by FIRST PASSAGE at the eighth pole, then gave way grudgingly. ROYAL CARD chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. R BROWN SUGAR stumbled at the start, raced three wide around the turn and couldn't keep pace in the drive. DONTTELLMEWHATTODO failed to menace. GOING TO THE SUN was not a factor. CASSIDYS PRIDE chased the early pace and tired. UNDERGROUND chased the pace into the turn, then faltered. TIME WELL SPENT broke awkwardly, prompted the pace outside KAYS AND JAYS to nearing the stretch, then faded.
